

HOW CAN HUMANS PRESERVE THE LAST FASCINATING AREAS OF WILDERNESS OF THE EARTH AND WITH IT THE DIVERSITY OF SPECIES?

THE THREE-PART DOCUMENTARY SERIES PROVIDES ANSWERS TO ONE OF THE MOST URGENT QUESTIONS OF HUMANITY.

he three-part documentary series **SAVE THE WILD** documents fascinating animal worlds in impressive landscapes. In a unique way, it also shows us that when scientists, rangers, zoo managers and locals work closely together and develop intelligent strategies, threatened animals can survive and natural areas be protected. With coordinated measures, the parties involved succeed in very different climatic zones of the earth to promote wild, seemingly untouched nature and slow the advance of humans into the last wilderness paradises of the world. Without their commitment and know-how, the extinction of species would progress unimpeded, eventually calling the survival of humans into question.

Biodiversity loss is one of the worst disasters in the world today. A recent report by the UN Biodiversity Council states that of the ten million or so species on earth, around one million are currently threatened with extinction. The rate of extinction due to human influence has now increased by a thousand fold compared to the natural rate. Habitat loss, massive over-fishing, or poaching are just some of factors.













Environmental pollution, the climate crisis and displacement of native flora and fauna by introduced species constitute additional threats. All three films in the series build on one other. Each documentary consists of three chapters, filmed in different locations and yet still thematically connected.

While the first film, "The Ark Principle", documents the rearing of endangered species in special protection zones, the second documentary, "Mission Wildnerness", highlights rescue operations for threatened animals, the return and protection of rare species in endangered zones with reduced game population. The third film, "Planned Paradises", plays in established protection zones known globally for their species richness and unique flora and fauna. The special challenge shown here is how can the natural balance be maintained in a protected area that's threatened by climate change and by large numbers of visitors. In the spirit of constructive journalism, our directors and authors document surprisingly new but already functioning solutions around the world.

Our team of **Apollofilm** and **Filmtank** is convinced that species protection is a global challenge and requires a diverse range of measures. With our three-part documentary series, we want to aesthetically express our enthusiasm for nature and the animals that call it home, and yet at the same time in a realistic and optimistic way. It depends on us as human beings whether we will preserve the beautiful wilderness paradises of our earth in the future or even reclaim the ones that have been lost.


